



Everyone likes a hug, but a gigantic Rice Krispie kiss is a real treat for your sweeties. Kids and parents can insert custom messages for each of their Valentines.

Valentine Kisses

Ingredients:

Prep: 5 minutes

6 cups Krispy Rice cereal

1 package marshmallows

3 Tbs margarine

Vegetable cooking spray

You will also need:

Funnel sprayed with cooking spray

12 inch square of aluminum foil

1 inch x 11 inch strip of paper or crepe paper

Waxed paper

Follow directions on the cereal box for making treats. As a variation, I added red food coloring to the melted marshmallows. Allow the mixture to cool slightly, until easy to handle. Have children spoon it into the funnel as a mold. Unmold. Place on waxed paper to cool completely before wrapping kiss in a square of aluminum foil.

Have the kids write a message on a piece of white paper or crepe paper. For instance, Be Mine, Happy Valentine's Day or Hugs and Kisses! Insert the message into the top of the foil kiss.

Tip: When forming the kisses, spray two baggies with vegetable cooking spray and place on your hands, oiled side out. This will keep your hands from getting sticky when handling the kisses.
